**Sec. 70-98. Water service billing.**

(b) If any customer issues a check to the city which is refused due to insufficient funds, the utilities department may collect a service charge from the customer of an amount established by resolution of the city council and on file in the city clerk's office. Additionally, the utility may require that future payments by the customer be in cash or by certified funds.

**FLORIDA STATUTE 166.251**

166.251 Service fee for dishonored check.--The governing body of a municipality may adopt a service fee not to exceed the service fees authorized under s. 832.08

- (a) Twenty-five dollars, if the face value does not exceed \$50.
- (b) Thirty dollars, if the face value is more than \$50 but does not exceed \$300.
- (c) Forty dollars, if the face value is more than \$300.
