

ORDINANCE 2011-06

AN ORDINANCE OF THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINNEOLA, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT BETWEEN LAKE COUNTY, FLORIDA AND THE CITY OF MINNEOLA, FLORIDA REGARDING THE MINNEOLA ATHLETIC COMPLEX; PROVIDING FOR CONFLICT WITH EXISTING ORDINANCES; PROVIDING FOR SEVERABILITY; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Minneola, Florida (the "City") owns property known as the Minneola Athletic Complex (the "Property"); and

WHEREAS, Lake County, Florida and the City are both interested in providing recreational facilities for residents of Minneola and areas surrounding the city limits; and

WHEREAS Lake County is desirous of locating a community park in the Minneola area; and

WHEREAS, Lake County and the City desire to cooperate in the maintenance and management of the Property in accordance with the terms of the Interlocal Agreement Between Lake County and City of Minneola (the "Agreement") attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference; and

WHEREAS, the City Council of the City of Minneola accordingly desires to pass this Ordinance 2011-06 to approve the Agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF MINNEOLA, FLORIDA:

Section 1. The City of Minneola City Council hereby approves the Agreement, attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and incorporated herein by reference, and authorizes the City Manager to execute the same.

Section 2. All ordinances in conflict with the provisions of this ordinance are hereby repealed.

Section 3. This Ordinance shall become effective immediately upon passing.

Section 4. If any section, sentence, clause, or phrase of this ordinance is held to be invalid or unconstitutional by any court of competent jurisdiction, then said holding shall in no way affect the validity of the remaining portion of this ordinance.
