

**Minneola Budget Hearing
Minutes
September 03, 2019 at 6:30 PM
Minneola City Hall**

The City of Minneola Budget Hearing was called to order by Mayor Pat Kelley. Also present were Vice Mayor Pam Serviss, Councilor Kelly Price, Councilor Joe Saunders, Scott Gerken (City Attorney), Mark Johnson (City Manager), and Barbara Hollerand (City Clerk). Councilor Lisa Jones was absent.

A moment of silence was observed, and the Pledge of Allegiance was led by Vice Mayor Serviss.

BUDGET HEARING

Scott Gerken announced that the purpose of the hearing was for the adoption of the tentative millage rate and the proposed budget for the fiscal year 2019-20.

Mark Johnson noted that property values have gone up in the last year. He stated that the proposed tentative millage rate is less than the rollback rate.

Mark Johnson distributed a Fiscal Year 2020 Budget – Current Notes & Assumptions handout and provided an overview of the budget highlights.

Vice Mayor Serviss thanked Mark Johnson and staff for their work on the budget.

Mayor Kelley announced that the tentative millage rate for 2019-20 is 6.1800. He said the rollback rate is 6.2911 and the tentative millage rate is less than the current rate.

Scott Gerken read Resolution 2019-18 by title only.

Mayor Kelley asked for public comments. There were no comments.


