# **GENERAL INFORMATION:**

ISO Class 3 Department, approximately 1,900 calls for service annually from one fire station servicing a population of about 13,000 residents. Currently the City is experiencing significant growth with plans for two additional fire stations.

- State of Florida Fire Officer 2
- State of Florida Paramedic License in Good Standing
- Current BLS for Healthcare Provider Certification
- Current Advanced Cardiac Life Support Certification
- Current Pediatric Advanced Life Support Certification
- 16-hour Emergency Vehicle Operator's Course (EVOC)
- Lake County Medical Director Clearance (Within 90 days of start date)

# **EXPERIENCE:**

At a minimum the applicant must have the following at the time of application:

- Minimum of five (5) years of experience in the fire service.
- Minimum of one (1) years of experience in emergency medical services as a paramedic
- Field supervisory experience in a position comparable to Lieutenant or demonstrated ability to function in the capacity of company officer (ride up).
- A comparable amount of training and/or education can be substituted for the minimum qualifications at the sole discretion of the review panel.

# ASSESSMENT:

Fire Team for Officers Testing will occur immediately after the interview. Any candidate that has completed the following requirements in the last 12 months will not be required to repeat unless they choose.

- Oral Interview
- Fire Team for Officers

# **PROBATION:**

If a candidate is selected for appointment to Lieutenant, candidate shall serve under a minimum of one year probationary period.
