In further consideration of the acceptance of my application for use of the Facility or inclusion in the Program, and for other good and valuable consideration, receipt is hereby acknowledged, I , both for myself, my party or group, my heirs, executors, personal representatives, administrators, and assigns, agree to indemnify and hold harmless the City of Minneola, it’s officials, employees, agents, representatives, successors and assigns for all liabilities, claims, actions, damages, costs or expenses, including attorney’s fees, assessed against them arising out of or in any way connected with my use of the Facility or participation in the Program, including travel and transportation to or from any event or activity connected therewith and the operation of any equipment necessary for participation in the event or activity, and including personal or bodily injuries, wrongful death or property damage which may be suffered by me or others before, during or after my use of the Facility or participation in the Program. I understand that this release, waiver, and indemnification includes, but is not limited to, any claims based on gross negligence, negligence, action or inaction on any of the above parties, and includes, but is not limited to, personal injury, bodily injury, wrongful death and property damage. I further understand that this release waiver and indemnification is intended to be as broad and inclusive as permitted by the laws of the State of Florida.

### Kickball Tournament Rules

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**Main Rule: Have fun, this is all for charity.**

The rules for kickball are closely related to those of baseball. The main difference is that kickball involved a big rubber ball that you kick ... duh!

Kickball is played on a field with 4 bases arranged on the corners of a diamond-shaped “infield”. Player positions are also similar to those of baseball.

There is an “infield” and an “outfield”. The infield contains the positions that involve the bases, while the outfield is mainly designated to catching or retrieving the ball when it is kicked out of the infield. Actual playing positions vary depending on the number of players that are actually playing.

#### **Game play goes as follows:**

The ball is rolled toward home plate, and the player which is up “kicking”, tries to kick the ball. Be prepared, the kicker and/or the pitcher, may give a “challenge”, i.e. blindfold, flippers, running the bases backwards, etc. This will be determined by, and we are sure they are unbiased, umpires/referees. (They may be bribed, but the money they collect, all goes to charity)

If the ball is caught in the air, the kicker is out. (Gloating from the opposing team may be warranted and encouraged)

A player is also out if the ball is thrown at them and hits them while they are not touching a base. (Please go easy on kids under 16. **All others beware.** This is 7<sup>th</sup> grade all over again!!)

Also similar to baseball, if the ball is thrown to the first baseman, and it is caught by the first baseman while he/she is touching first base, the player running to first base is out.

Once a team gets 3 outs, the teams switch sides. A team gets one point for having a runner make it all the way around the bases and back to home base. It is urged to use the “Buy-a-Base” Program. This can be done anytime during your teams up to kick.

The game is over, typically 3 to 5 innings, this will depend on how many teams are playing. Or the ball pops or the ball is lost.

However, if a team loses the ball that team automatically loses. Also, the kicker that did it because **instantly unpopular.**

At the end of the game, the team with the most points wins. (See our “Buy-a-Base” Program if you want to guarantee a win. There may be a bracket system in place and the winner at the end wins the Trophy, and the right to dance and scream “in your face” to the opposing team. Singing “We are the Champions” is optional.
